Lake Murvaul May Soon Be Bass Hot Spot

Murvaul is typical of the many East Texas lakes. With a shoreline of 85 miles it stores an estimated 45,000 acre feet of water behind an earthen dam 8,000 feet long and a 275 foot concrete spillway.

RESIDENTS of the county also have accomplished considerable development of the surrounding area. There are ample boat docks and launching ramps.

Lake Murvaul is filled with the run-off of almost 200 square miles. Here in the timberlands of East Texas rainfall is fairly high.

Roberts Wins Discus, But Loses Shot Put To Matson

Danny Roberts, senior weightman from Cleveland, tossed the discus 170-8 Saturday to win that event at the U. S. Track and Field Federation Nationals in Jepperson Stadium, Houston.

But the 6-3, 245-pounder had to step down from his Texas throne in the shot put when high school whiz Randy Matson of Pampa lobbed the steel sphere 60-6 to set a new state mark.

Roberts, who set the Southwest Conference records in both shot and discus last month at the league

meet, finished second in the shot put Saturday with a 59 3/4 heave.

MATSON HAD the second best college discus throw by a high schooler in history, 169-7 1/2, to finish second.

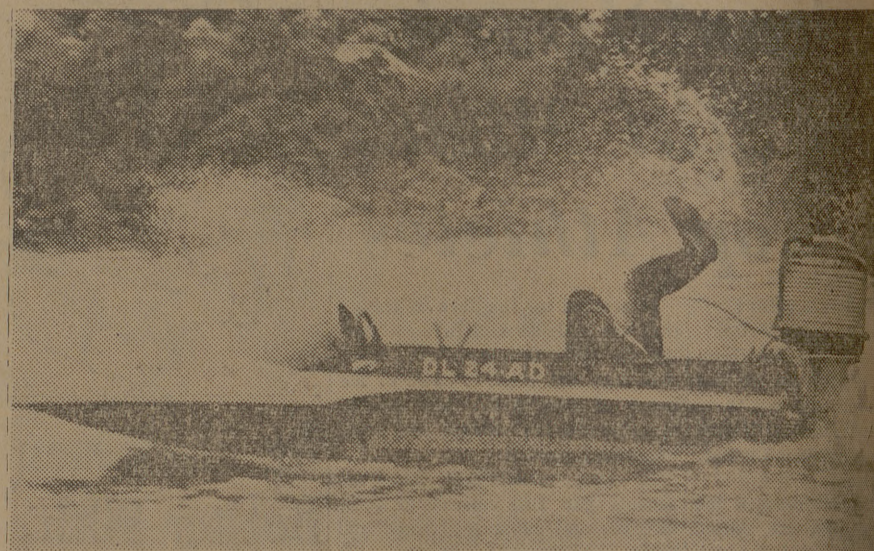
A second Aggie senior, 6-2, 145-pound Jerry Anderson from Gorman, turned in a 48.4 time for a fourth place in the 440-yard dash. Adolph Plummer of the New Mexico Track Club had the top 440 time with 47.2.

In the 440-yard dash preliminaries Anderson and Jack O'Neil

of the Louisiana Track Club, who was third in the finals, had the top performances of 47.9.

Olympic-aspirant Janice Rinehart, the 19-year-old YWCA secretary from Abilene, dominated women's competition at the meet. She won the 220-yard dash with a stadium record time of 25.4.

MISS RINEHART also led the Texas Track Club girls' team to a 440-yard dash win with 49.3. She ran the anchor leg after Sue Schexnayder, Paula Walter, and Mary Rose.
