

Hall Will Present Paper In France

Dr. Wayne C. Hall of A&M plans to leave Saturday to present a paper at an international conference July 15-20 near Paris, France. He will return here after visiting briefly Oxford University and the University of London after the conference.

The A&M graduate dean is one of 19 Americans among 38 scientists from over the world invited to participate in the Fifth International Conference on Natural Plant Growth Regulators. Only scientists presenting papers may attend.

Hall is a professor of plant physiology as well as dean of the graduate school. He participated in the fourth international conference held in 1959.

His paper to the conference this year at Gif-sur-Yvette is entitled, "Interrelations Between Ethylene and Auxins." The coauthor is Dr. Page W. Morgan, an assistant professor in the Department of Plant Sciences.

Hall was invited by the executive committee of the conference and the French Minister of Education and Science.

his area of immediate research interest and the workshop agenda. The purpose of the workshop is to stimulate research, both basic and applied, in the field of mar-
