

318 Manuscripts Given To Archives

A collection of speeches on Texas agriculture spanning the past 35 years was presented to A&M's archives last week by A. L. Ward of Dallas.

Ward, educational director of the National Cottonseed Products Association from 1926 until his retirement in 1957, donated manuscripts of 318 of his speeches made to agricultural and business groups during his career. An A&M graduate in 1910 and a former Agricultural Extension swine husbandryman, Ward has spoken on the history and progress of Texas agriculture throughout the state.

In accepting the material, President Earl Rudder noted that the speeches will serve both as information and inspiration to students.

The gift was prompted by Fred Hale, professor of animal hus-

bandry at A&M, who wrote Ward when the Cottonseed Products office in Dallas was consolidated with one in Memphis, Tenn. Hale asked if Ward's manuscripts could be retained in A&M's archives for study by Texans.

 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE QUESTION OF REZONING THOSE PARTS OF LOTS 31 AND 32 PRESENTLY ZONED IN DISTRICT NO. 2, SECOND BUSINESS DISTRICT AND DISTRICT NO. 1, APARTMENT HOUSE DISTRICT, IN THE D. A. SMITH SUBDIVISION, TO DISTRICT NO. 4, FIRST BUSINESS DISTRICT.
 BE IT ORDAINED BY the City Council of the City of College Station, Texas: WHEREAS, the City Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended that the land described herein be rezoned as District No. 4, First Business District.
 It is hereby ordered that a public hearing shall be held in the City Hall at 7:00 P. M. on September 23, 1963, on rezoning certain areas within the limits, more particularly described as follows:
 Those parts of Lots 31 and 32 presently zoned District No. 2, Second Business District and District No. 1, Apartment House District in the D. A. Smith Subdivision, to District No. 4, First Business District.
