Interns in the special National Aeronautics and Space Administration program recently received certificates of graduation and returned for fall semester classes at various colleges.

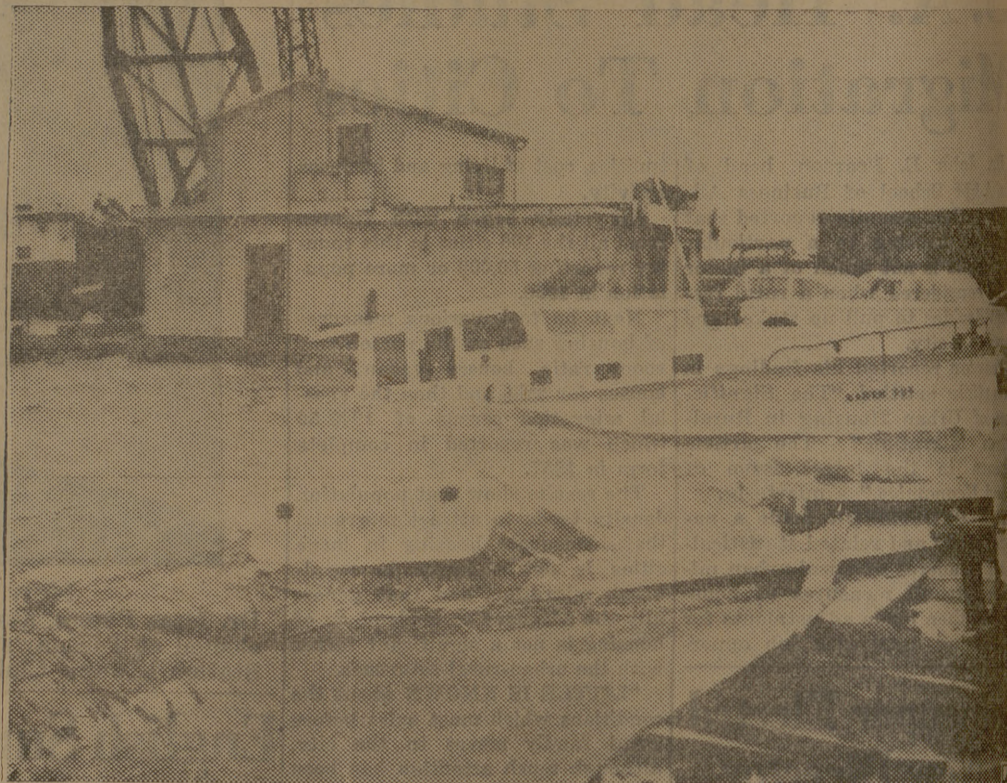
The unique program, according to Manned Spacecraft Center Director Dr. Robert Gilruth, gives
