Carpenter Feels Cadets Are Ready For Steers

Ronnie Carpenter, Aggie end and alternate captain, left little doubt that he would change "now" to "then" when the scores are totaled after the gun sounds ending the traditional Turkey Day clash between A&M and Texas.

The senior from Marshall wore an aura of determination as he voiced his thoughts on the upcoming contest with top-ranked UT. "We can win if we want to bad enough, and we want to bad enough."

Carpenter, 6-3, 213-pounder, is one of the two iron men in the Aggie line. He and junior guard Ronney Moore are the only Cadets who have started every game. Carpenter has caught five passes for 100 yards but has been most outstanding as the outside man on the big A&M defensive line.

Head Coach Hank Foldberg has only praise for the rangy senior. "Ronnie gives 100 percent every minute he's in there. He's a good leader and inspires confidence in the younger boys."

Usually quiet and reserved when off the gridiron, Carpenter loses all traces of shyness when Texas

is the subject of conversation. "We're ready for them. We've taken it on the chin from them for three years. This time it's going to be different."

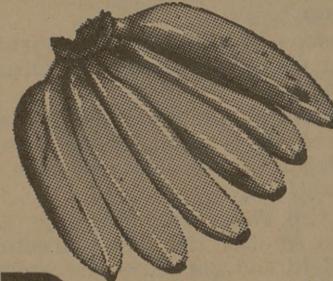
