If possible, these students approximately 800, will be housed in the "New Area" consisting of Dormitories 1-12. However, Hart, Walton and Puryear Halls may also be used in an effort to keep overcrowding at an absolute minimum, said Hannigan. Students will be notified of their block assignments and the availability of rooms before Christmas.

A chilled water cooling system will be installed in the dormitories. Some of the changes to the individuals rooms will include change of closet arrangement, new desk, built-in bookcases, and different beds which may be "stacked" or arranged separately. Rent will be increased from \$20 to \$30 per month in these remodeled dormitories, Hannigan said.
