Engineers Produce Handbook

A pocket-size book of instructions on building homes of earth has been produced by engineering researchers at A&M.

The handbook was written by Lyle A. Wolfskill, Wayne A. Dunlap and Bob M. Gallaway of A&M's Texas Transportation Institute. It offers information for building homes of adobe, rammed earth and

machine-made earth blocks in a country of the world.

The publication includes 95 how-to-do sketches and photos to aid builders and also contains useful formulas and conversion tables for weights and measures.

The U. S. Office of International Housing plans to send the publication to a number of underdeveloped countries.
