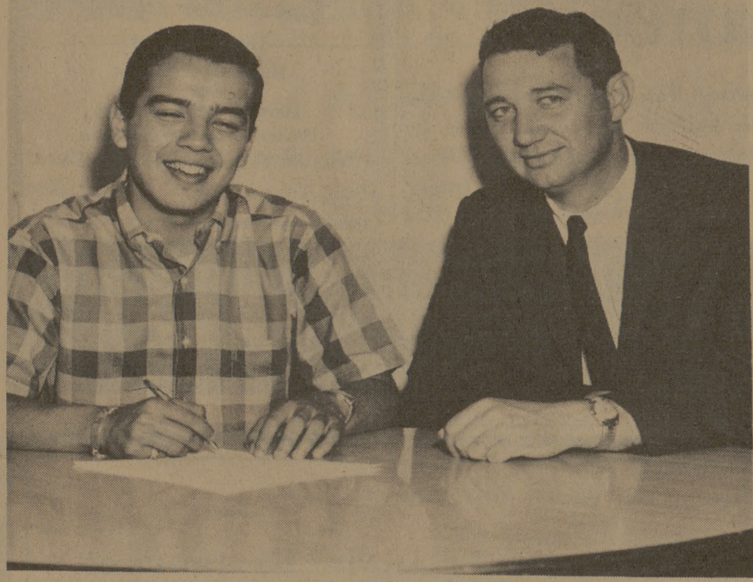


Shelby's Crew Increases 2

Coach Shelby Metcalf's basketball family increased by two recently—this time from the junior college set—when Southwest Conference championship cage coach and recruiter landed Eddie Dominguez of Lon Morris and Wiley Jenkins of Kilgore.

Jenkins, who hails from Cayuga, was captain of the Ranger quintet this past season and was elected the most valuable player on the squad by his teammates.

Scouting reports state that the 6-foot-2 recruit is strong on defense and a good shooter and rebounder.

Dominguez, 5-10, averaged 20 points per game in Texas Eastern Conference play this past season for the Bearcats. Dominguez played high school basketball at Thomas Jefferson in Dallas.

When Jenkins and Dominguez hit the floor at G. Rollie White Coliseum next fall it will be more like a reunion than a basketball practice.

Jenkins had two brothers who played under Metcalf when the Aggie mentor coached at Cayuga on his first job.

Golfers Meet UT In Survival Fight

The Aggie golf team will be seeking a big win over the Texas Longhorns Friday in Austin and its fifth straight Southwest Conference championship.

It will be a big task for the Cadets who need a 5-1 win in order to get a piece of the title with Texas Tech or a 5½-1½ or shut-out to take the crown outright.

The Steers, who were in the lead until a 4-2 jolt by TCU Tuesday, 22-13½, one half point ahead of the Aggies who are at 22-14.

Texas Tech, 27-15, finished its season Monday and stands a good chance of winning the conference if the Ags and 'Horns split.

The Forty Acres golfers, sporting one of their strongest teams in recent years, have on their line-

up Bill Munn, 1962 Border Olympics champion; Pat Thompson, 1963 semifinalist in the NCAA; Randy Geiselman, 1963 NCAA quarter-finalist; and Eugene Mitchell, owner of the Houston Golf Assn. scholarship.

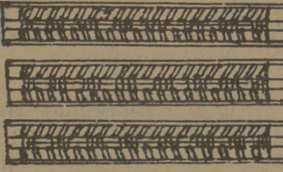
