

## Annual A&M Invitational Meet Set For Saturday Afternoon

The sixth annual A&M University Invitational Cross Country Meet is expected to attract 52 teams in three divisions here Saturday afternoon.

There will be four divisions of competition — Class AAAA high schools, Class AAA and lower in high school, university for and senior college and university-college. The university-college class will compete over a three-mile race while the other three divisions will compete at two miles.

The A&M varsity entry brings a record to the meet. Their defeat came at the hands of University of Houston two weeks ago.

They defeated Baylor and Oregon State in a tri-meet Friday in Reno. The sophomore-dominated meet aggregation has been paced the early meets by Danny Cliff.

First action starts at 3 p.m. Saturday. The final race is scheduled for 4 p.m.

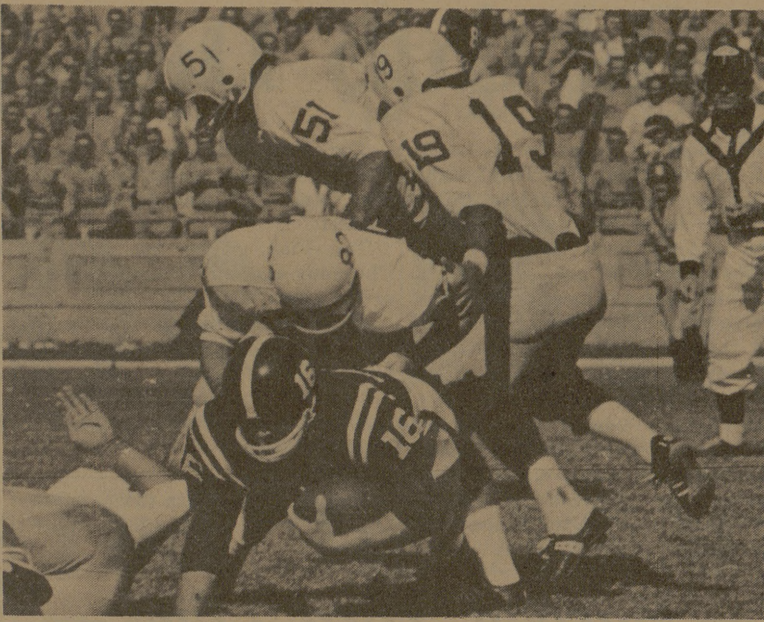
