

Aggie Cagers Seek Revenge In Tonight's Tilt With Tigers

The undefeated Memphis State Tigers barrel into G. Rollie White Coliseum Thursday night to do battle with the revenge-bent Aggies at 8 p.m.

Memphis State clipped the Aggies in their season opener, 82-73 in Memphis last week. Since then the Ags have chalked up three straight victories. The Tigers were backed by a near-capacity crowd of 8,700 in the new Mid-South Coliseum when they played the Aggies.

Aggie John Hillman whipped in 22 points to pace nine field goals, nearly all from the outside, in that contest. MSU shot at a 53.8 per

cent in spoiling the Cadet debut. The Tigers have become a perennial cage power. It has been 12 years since the Tennessee school last suffered a losing season. They are coached by Dean Ehlers, in his third year at the helm. He served as assistant coach at MSU the previous six years.

A&M Coach Shelby Metcalf will go with the same five he has started all season. They will be a determined crew as they try to avenge the lone blemish on their record.

Since the MSU tilt the Ags have knocked off Southern Miss-

issippi, Arlington State, and Sam Houston State. Their 3-1 slate is second only to Baylor in the SWC.

Center John Beasley has provided the scoring punch for the Aggies thus far. The East Texan has been averaging 27 points a contest. Three other Aggies are averaging in double figures.

The high-scoring Cadets are racking up buckets at a 82.0 points per game clip. They have allowed enemy quintets 72.5 points per game.

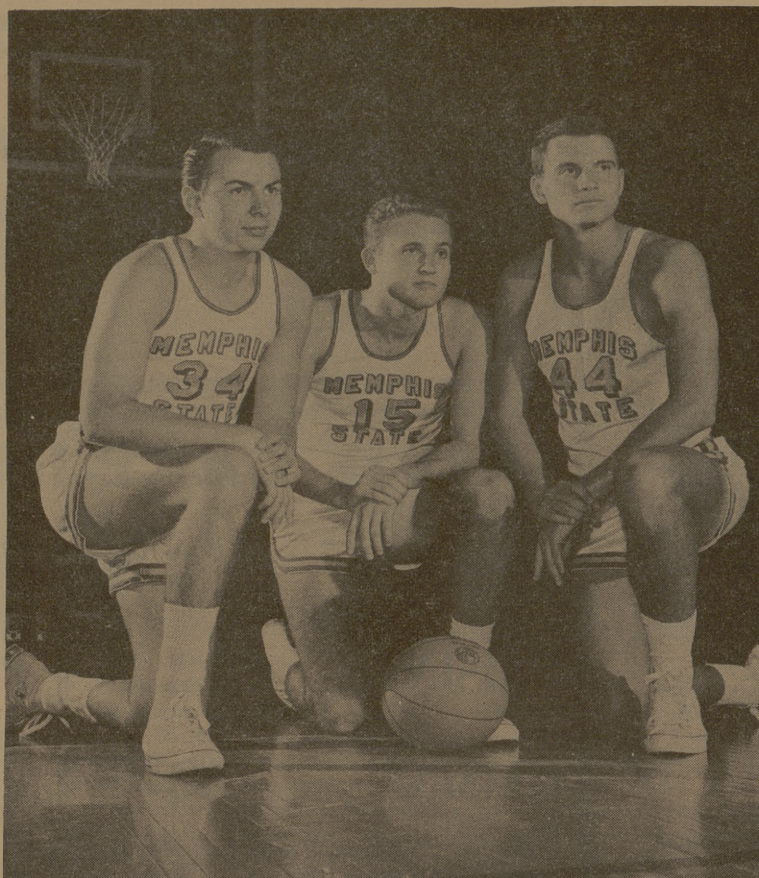
Captain Paul Timmins suffered a cut forehead in the game with Sam Houston State Tuesday night. He is expected to be in the starting line-up against MSU, though.
