

Chamber Drive Nears End

The 1965 Bryan-College Station Chamber of Commerce membership drive goes into its final three days today still short of the anticipated 1,000 members and \$63,558 budget goal.

Clark Munroe, director of personnel at A&M and chairman of the campus portion of the drive, urged all faculty and staff members who haven't returned their membership cards to do so this week.

"The Chamber of Commerce does many things for A&M and works to make the twin city area a better place for us to live. Without our support, they can't achieve their goals. When this happens it affects all of us, not just the businessmen," he said.
