Moon Landing Only Solution Says Slayton

MILWAUKEE, Wis (A)-Astronaut Donald K. Slayton said Tuesday that he didn't think space scientists would be sure about landing conditions on the moon "until one of our guys gets up there and takes a look."

Slayton, 41, a Saprta, Wis., native who was in Milaukee as honorary state chairman of the Easter Seal campaign-of which his 10year old niece, Barbara, is poster girl-took time out to discuss space flights.

Shrinkage in the goals of the two-man Gemini program has not hurt the Apollo moon flight effort scheduled for 1969, Slayton said. The first manned Gemini orbital flight is scheduled for late March or early April.

Originally, designers hoped to build a Gemini capsule which could be brought down on land, he said. They experimented with a kite like folding wing and a steerable parachute, but neither will be ready for use before the Gemini program, ends, he added.

Slayton, an Air Force major, one of the nation's original astronauts, was forbidden to fly in the oneman Mercury program because of a minor heart defect. He said that no decision has been made on his qualifications to fly in multimanned space vehicles.
