## **Renaissance** Era To Be Discussed

The culture of the Renaissance period will be discussed when humanities scholars from six states gather at A&M Friday and Saturday. In session will be the fourteenth annual South-Central Renaissance Conference.

About 100 persons are expected to attend.

Registration begins at 8 a. m. Friday. President Earl Rudder will welcome the scholars at 9 a. m. Then the pre-sentation of lectures begins and continues through the day. Delegates will hear the Rev. Dr. Walter J. Ong, S. J. professor of English at St.

Louis University, as banquet speaker at 6 p. m. Friday. He is an internationally known scholar of medieval and Renaissance culture and a commenta-tor on modern life.


