# Enrollment In Special Russian Course Doubles

Enrollment of doctoral students has doubled in one year for a Texas A&M Russian language course.

A&M is said to be one of four universities in the nation offering the special course in scientific Russian.

Enrollment totals 51 graduate students in two sections. The course was first taught last summer to one section with 25 students.

Professor John M. Skrivaneck teaches the course formally entitled "Introduction to Scientific

Russian." He is a native Texan who completed doctoral studies in Slavic languages at Charles University in Prague before the Communist takeover in Czechoslovakia.

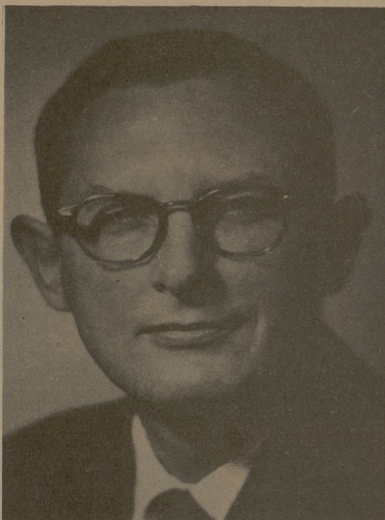
Wagner is completing his research for the Ph.D. in biochem-

Dr. Edwin Doran, Jr., an associate professor of geography at Texas A&M since 1960, has been named assistant dean of the new College of Geosciences at A&M.

Announcement of Doran's appointment was made by President Earl Rudder.

Dr. Doran also will retain his position as associate professor of geography. He holds a Ph.D. in geography from the University of California at Berkeley, a master in geology and geography from Louisiana State University, and a bachelor of arts degree in geology from LSU.

A native of Baton Rouge, Dr. Doran attended school there. He served in the Corps of Engineers during World War II.

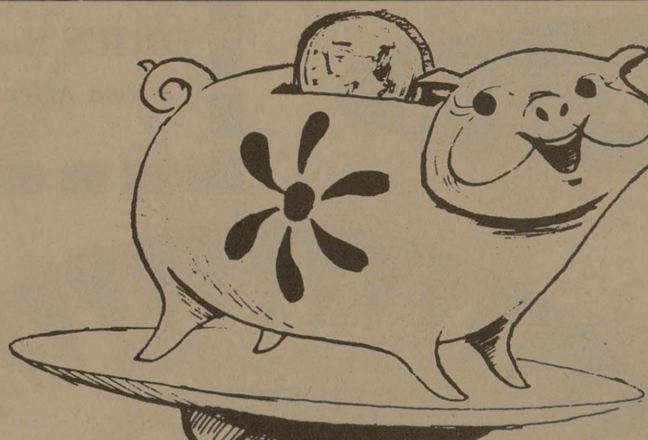
