33 Education Students Debut In Classroom TV Simulation

Thirty-three television stars made their screen debut at Texas A&M recently, but none of them will likely ever hit the Hollywood bigtime.

Television Department, which runs a four-channel closed circuit to three buildings on the campus, Parker's students met the TV problem first hand.

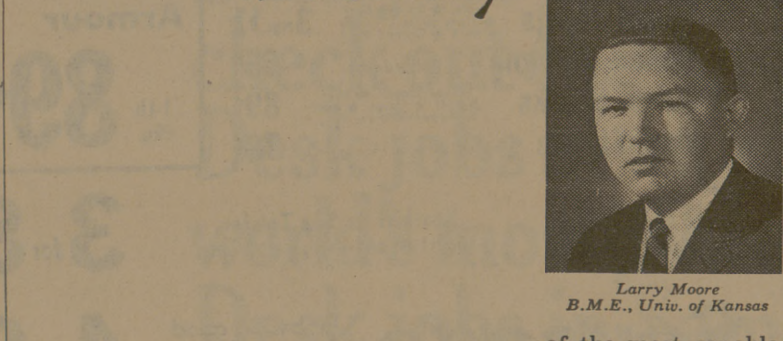
