Research Ship Begins Geological Cruise

A geological cruise by Texas A&M's oceanographic research ship, the Alaminos, began Mon-

Visiting scientist Mario Gutierrez of the Geology Institute of Mexico will make the twoweek cruise. William Bryant is chief scientist.

Research data will be gathered primarily through long coring and bathymeter measurements, Dr. Leo Berner of the Department of Oceanography said. The cruise, to return March 18, will trace a path toward Panama City south to the Sigsbee Knolls, the Bay of Campeche and east to the coast of Mexico.

The Alaminos returned to Galveston last week from a twoweek ocean temperature study cruise in the Gulf of Mexico.


