## Prof Authors Second Book

Meteorologist John F. Griffiths of Texas A&M has his second book in as many years rolling off Oxford University presses in England. "Applied Climatology" is an 80,000-word volume of introductory nature. Griffiths expects it to fill needs of high school, college students and laymen interested in how climate affects environment. "This is the first book dealing specifically with the subject in the English language," noted the Meteorology Department associate professor. He said there is growing interest in environmental sciences. The general treatise devotes chapters to climate and humans, animals, agriculture, forestry and buildings, to name a few.
