# First Female Math Prof Likes Astronomy, Music

A classical piano playing teacher with a yen for astronomy is at Texas A&M.

Dr. Ruth E. Goodman joined the department this summer under new math head Dr. Morris Ostrofsky. She will organize college algebra, teach three courses of 102 and senior-level modern algebra.

Being the first lady math prof at A&M isn't a new experience for Miss Goodman, who said she had a similar honor at an earlier
