The new branch of the department is made up of local men who work under the leadership of Brazos County Sheriff J. W. Hamilton, College Station-Texas A&M Auxiliary Police Chief Bill Scott and Texas A&M Police Chief Ed Powell.

The object of the new department is to prepare the county and cities for local and state emergencies, and if such a need ever arises, a national emergency. In order to accomplish this, the Auxiliary Police Force was formed to supplement the local police departments in emergencies

or whenever needed. The men who make up the auxiliary force go through a thorough training program, directed by the three local Civil Defense directors. They are taught emergency procedures which can be put to practice quickly and efficiently when they

are called on. Texas A&M Police Chief Powell said the auxiliary police function in instances other than emergencies, such as at Texas A&M home football games. They are assigned to different areas to help park cars and at strategic intersections to direct the heavy traffic.




