Differences in height, weight, dy surface, metabolism, pulse respiration rate, capacity, od pressure, vertical jump, retion time, scholastic aptitude, ading ability and grades were easured in 42 members of a iverstiy track team.

Results showed a statistically gnificant difference in weight, pacity, pulse rates and vertical np. Distance runners in the oup averaged eight pounds ghter, had 500 cubic centimeters ore capacity and tended to rever normal pulse rate more pidly after exertion. Sprinters rpassed distance runners in the tical jump by four inches.
