Saturday's **Forecast** Looks Fine

Football and weather forecasts are looking up at Texas A&M, where the Aggies meet Texas Christian University Saturday

A&M handily defeated Texas Tech and tied a strong Louisiana State team in its last two games. Long-range weather forecasts promise near ideal circumstances for the 7:30 p.m. Saturday game.

The Weather Station of A&M's Meteorology Department forecasts partly cloudy skies, 75 to 78 degree temperatures and winds south to southeast at 10 mph for the TCU contest.

"We'll have less than a 10 per cent chance of rain Saturday night," predicted Jim Lightfoot, station manager.

He said station charts indicate heavier than normal precipitation the next five days, with .3 to .4 inches the average. Low clouds and rain today and tomorrow should break Thursday evening and come back in on a Gulf flow Saturday and Sunday afternoons.

Afternoon rain showers are normal for the projected flow of wind off the Gulf," he added.




