'Effective Speech Brings Results'

Learning to say effectively what you have to say brings maximum results to both yourself and your listener, a communications expert said Wednesday at Texas A&M University.

Jack F. Wolfram, president of the Jack Wolfram Foundation, which promotes, among other things, more efficient speaking and listening, spoke to 30 participants in a management seminar sponsored by A&M's School of Business.

"As general manager of the Oldsmobile Division of General Motors for 14 years, I was impressed with the number of people with a great deal of potential who could not express themselves effectively," Wolfram said. "By this, I mean man-to-man, in group meetings and with co-workers. Some of them wondered why they had not advanced."

"Since I formed the foundation, I have emphasized in my campus and university importance of better oral communications programs," Wolfram continued. "Decisions and better ideas than you start with, it's of no help to you."

Wolfram was to be guest honor at a Wednesday night dinner at Briarcrest Country Club.

"I am including Texas A&M my future talks around the country," he remarked after with the A&M Executive Committee and students. "I'm impressed with the depth of learning here. I had not expected capable an institution. The students and faculty seem to have a sense of rapport and respect."
