## A&M Awarded \$60,784 Grant For Seminar

Texas A&M University has been awarded a \$60,784 grant under the National Defense Education Act for a 1967 Summer Institute in English.

The eight-week seminar begins June 5 and ends July 28, noted Institute Director J. S. Jernigan, assistant professor of English. Participants include 40 English teachers with a minimum of three years' teaching experience in grades 7 through 12.

Jernigan said literature and language will be taught, with participants to receive six hours credit toward advanced degrees. In the past two institutes, nine hours credits could be earned. Jernigan said the number of hours will be reduced to relieve pressure on students.

The English Institute began at A&M in 1965 under a \$54,803 grant. A&M received \$61,011 last summer.

"Composition will be taught as a coordinating course for language and literature," Jernigan explained. "About one third of the time will be spent in discussion and practical application of new methods for presenting subject matter."

The institute staff includes Dr. Harrison E. Hieth in language, Dr. Carroll D. Lavery in literature, and Dr. Harry P. Kroitor in composition. Tom R. McElroy of Bellaire High School, Houston, will supervise the institute workshop.

Dr. Lee J. Martin, A&M English Department head, will serve as a consultant.

Three guest lecturers are to be named.

### Prof Will Speak At Dedication Of New Bridge City Sims School

Dr. Paul Hensarling of Texas A&M University will be principal speaker for dedication of a new Bridge City elementary school Sunday.

The E. E. Sims Elementary School will be dedicated at 2:30 p.m. The new Bridge City structure is named for Dr. E. E. Sims, superintendent of the Bridge City Independent School District since 1962.

"The new elementary school is a monument to Bridge City people who support good education for their children," Dr. Hensarling said.

"Naming the school for Dr. Sims indicates they are willing to support the programs and administration," the Education and Psychology Department head added.

Bridge City citizens voted two facility improvement bond issues in the last four years. The district doubled its facilities in the same period, has another bond issue before the public, enrolled 2,700 students this fall—compared to 1,000 eight years ago—and is gaining state-wide recognition for its multi-level, weighted grades program.
