# Two Join Staff In Engineering

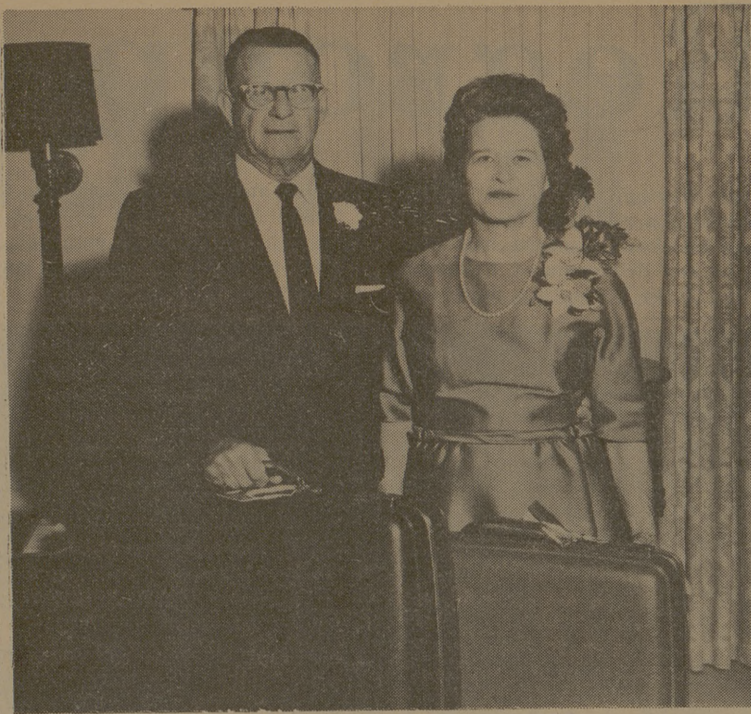
Dr. Joseph S. Osoba and Richard A. Morse have been named to the Petroleum Engineering staff at Texas A&M University.

Dr. Robert L. Whiting, Petroleum Engineering Department head, said Dr. Osoba has been appointed to a professor's rank. Morse is a lecturer.

Dr. Osoba earned the B.S. in physics from the University of Texas and the Ph.D. from Washington University, St. Louis, Mo. He has 17 years drilling and production experience with Humble Oil and Refining Company's Research Division and is an international authority on well logging and formation evaluation.

Morse comes to A&M from Venezuela, where he was manager of the Eastern Division for Mene Grande Oil Company. He has worked for several oil companies in exploration and production research and is an authority on petroleum reservoir engineering. He has a B.S. degree in petroleum engineering from the University of Oklahoma and a M.S. from Pennsylvania State.

Dr. Osoba has taught in academic institutions, in the military and industry. He was a lieutenant commander in the U. S. Navy during World War II. Dr.
