Firemen's Rescue Training School Set Next Week At Brayton Field

A heavy duty rescue training school by Texas A&M's Engineering Extension Service is set Nov. 14-18 at Brayton Field. Tom Robinson, Firemen's Training School instructor, will head the school at Disaster City, a three-story structure used in simulating various rescue operations.

Participation will be limited to 25 men to allow maximum individual instruction. Guest instructors include Theo H. Felds, chief of Houston-Harris County Civil Defense Rescue Services; Tom Morgan, Nacogdoches fire captain; Paul Stanforth, Galveston fire captain; and Harold R. Sorensen, Brazos County Civil Defense Rescue Service.

The course is taught in cooperation with the Texas Department of Public Safety and the Office of Defense and Disaster Relief. Topics include emergency methods of picking up and carrying casualties, firefighting operations, first aid, tunneling and shafting, reconnaissance, rescue from heights by ladder slide, life basket, and telpher line.

Another feature of the course will be a night rescue operation under simulated emergency conditions. Student teams will carry out rescue operations under supervision of the instructional staff.
