Sports has a way of getting into the blood of certain writers, and though they try to leave it, they are inevitably drawn back.

So, here I am again, watching the action From The Sidelines.

Observing the latest stats from those in the SWC who spend their time computing such things, we see Aggie QB Edd Hargett is leading the field in total offense with 1477 total yards, all but 24 coming through the air. He is first in passing yardage with 1453, but is second in completions with 123 of 348. Terry Southall leads with 126 completions of 251 attempts.

On the other end of these numerous flings, Tommy Maxwell has gathered in 27 for 445 yards to be rated third in the conference. Steve O'Neal is third in punting with 62 for a 42.4 average. He leads in the number of punts.

Looking elsewhere on the sporting scene, we see where the fight in Houston the other night between Cassius Clay and the now-retired Cleveland Williams didn't quite make that \$1 million live gate. Actual figures put the gross at \$422,918 from an indoor fight record 35,460 fans.

Since the fight, like most in Ali's series, left something to be desired, the Houston sports association has turned to bragging about the record number of beers sold for the event: over 15,000. I guess the fans needed something to offer excitement!

Speaking of attendance, the SWC grid fans came to see the action this year in record numbers: 1,387,761 thus far for a 7.2 per cent increase over 1965. The Aggies have played before 89,120, with a probable 60,000 more to watch the Turkey Day classic.

The Fish gridders, go into the Shorthorn match Saturday with a 2-2 record. Like the varsity, a win over TU will give them a winning record for the year.

## Dickey Back Of Week

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. (AP) — Arkansas tailback David Dickey, a soft spoken Texan, has started only three games in his college career but already has an Associated Press College Back-of-the-Week honor.

"Other than playing for Arkansas, this is the greatest honor I've ever had," said the 204-pound sophomore.

Dickey was named the Back of the Week Wednesday for his performance in Arkansas' 22-0 conquest of Southern Methodist, a triumph that left the sixth-ranked Razorbacks only one victory away from a third straight Cotton Bowl appearance.

"It's kind of unbelievable," he said. "But it seems sort of secondary now that I learned about Claude Smithey."

Smithey, a Razorback tackle died Tuesday in a Houston, Tex. hospital where he had been unconscious since a three-hour brain operation Oct. 29 following his collapse in the Arkansas dressing room after a game.

Dickey, who lives at Palestine, Tex., scored two touchdowns and gained 133 yards on 38 blasts at the heart of a touted SMU interior line. He scored eight TD's in the last three games and moved him into the Southwest Conference scoring lead. He be-

came a starter against Texas A&M when Bruce Maxwell pulled a hamstring muscle in practice.

Dickey said he was too keyed up to think about being tired during his workhorse duties against SMU. The 38 carries set a conference record.

"In fact, I got so keyed up the Thursday before the game that I thought I was going to have to take a tranquilizer," he said.

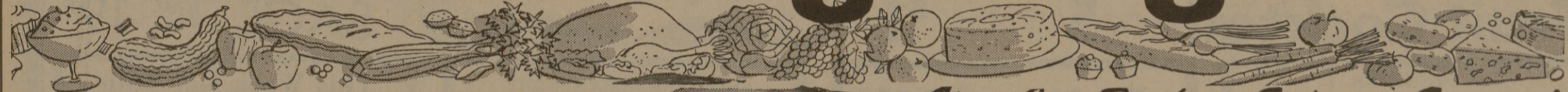
