This choice was no longer possible because of Manchester's book, he said.

In the interests "of unmanaged history," Connally said, "I have concluded that we have no choice but to assemble and present the facts and details as we know them . . . in the hope that presentday writers and legitimate historians might find them useful in reaching objective judgments."

CONNALLY DID not say, or give newsmen a chance to ask, if he had read the book or the magazine or if he was basing his re-

John Tower, R.-Tex., revealed from his Washington office that he had received a fake bomb in the mail after the assassination, apparently sent by someone who thought conservatives were responsible for Kennedy's death. Police asked him at the time not to disclose the matter, Tower said.

Dallas Mayor Erik Jonsson said Manchester's characterization of Dallas as a city with a "disease of the spirit, a shrill, hysterical note suggesting a deeply troubled society" was in-

"DALLAS WAS a town glad to see its Presdent on that day," Johnson said. "We were concerned with entertaining him and the most elaborate methods were used to make him welcome."
