

# Teasips Too Much For 'Good Sports'

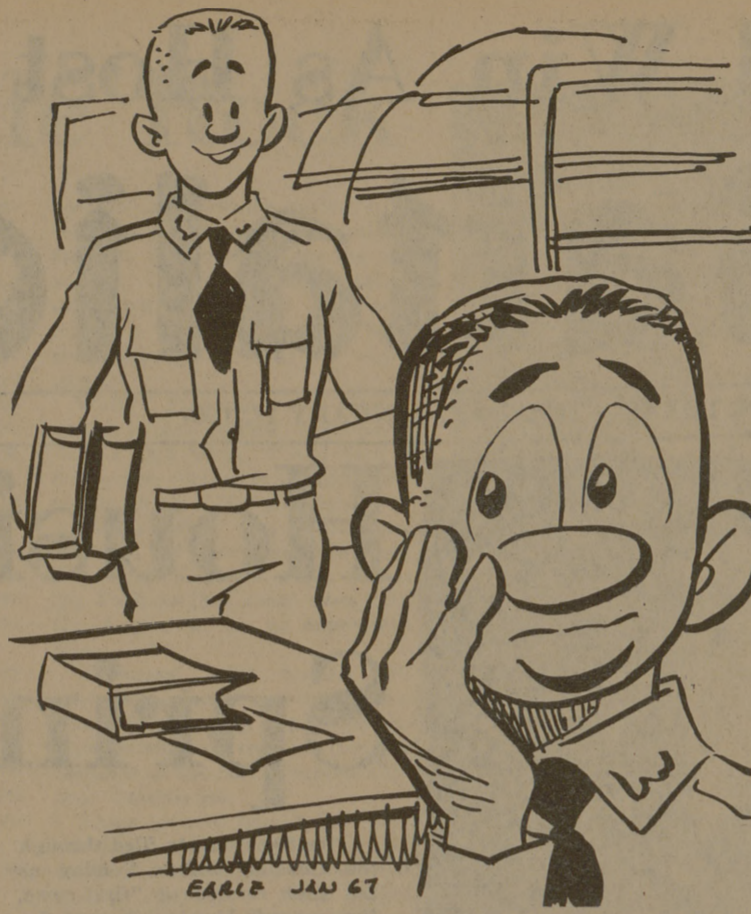

### Freeman To Lead Weather Seminar

Dr. John C. Freeman, Jr., director of research at the Institute for Storm Research at Houston's University of Saint Thomas, will give a meteorology seminar at 3 p.m. Thursday in Room 305, Goodwin Hall.

Dr. Freeman, a former assistant professor of oceanography here, will present the seminar on "Some Criticisms of the Lax-Wendroff Computing Scheme."

Dr. Freeman received his B.A. degree from Rice University in 1941, his M.S. in 1942 from the California Institute of Technology and his Ph.D. from the University of Chicago in 1952.

He participated in the early experiments in numerical weather prediction at the Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton. Upon leaving his position as an assistant professor of oceanography here, he founded Gulf Consultants in College Station.

AUSTIN, Tex. (AP) Lt. Gov. Preston Smith, addressing a group of Texas Democrats gathered to celebrate his and Gov. John Connally's new terms of office, Monday night took a verbal slap at author William Manchester.

Smith, speaking to a \$25-a-plate dinner at Austin Memorial Auditorium, said Manchester, author of "The Death of a President," was the Democratic committee's first choice for a speaker.

"We had hoped to bring in the well-known fiction writer, Mr. William Manchester," Smith said, "But he could not come. He was too busy working on his next book — a new history of Texas, to be entitled: "Santa Anna Was Right'."

Santa Anna was the head of the Mexican Army when Texas won its independence from Mexico.

## 400 Participants Expected For Industries' Symposium

Approximately 400 participants from all areas of the nation are expected for the 22nd Annual Symposium on Instrumentation for the Process Industries starting here Wednesday.

Dr. R. G. Anthony, symposium director, said the three-day conference is primarily concerned with instrumentation applied by continuous fluid flow process industries, including petroleum refineries, chemical plants, natural gas and cycling plants.

Anthony is assistant professor of chemical engineering at A&M. Nine industry experts will present technical papers on applied instrumentation during the symposium.

A&M President Earl Rudder will welcome symposium participants at 9 a.m. Wednesday in the Memorial Student Center Ballroom.

Immediately following is the keynote address by Dr. John G. Truxal, provost for Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn. "Future Developments in Instrumentation Scientific Knowledge" is his topic. Beat t.u.

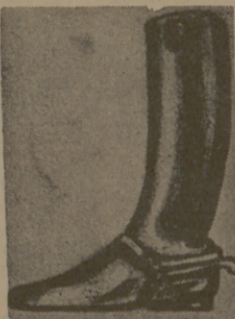

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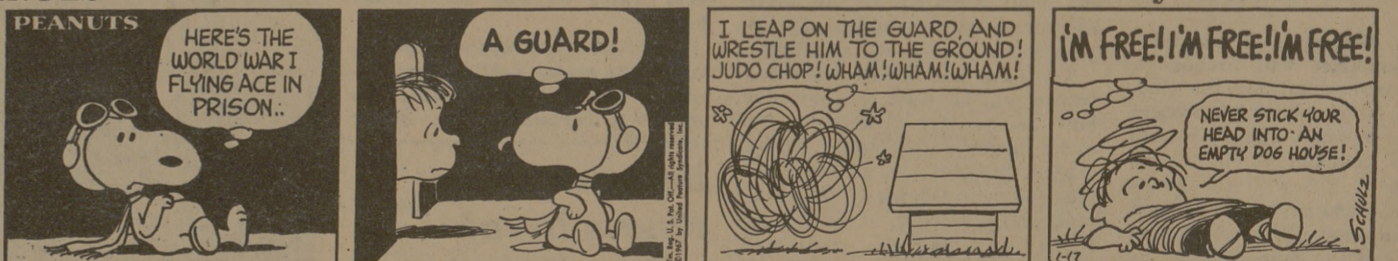

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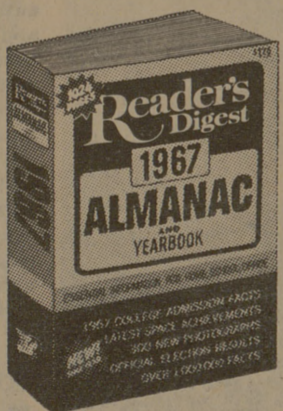
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
