

A six-week polygraph examiner's school by Texas A&M's Police Training Division is scheduled March 20-April 28 at the A&M Research Annex.

Instructor Ira Scott said the course is designed to develop qualified persons in law enforcement, industrial security and personnel investigation in theory techniques and operation of the polygraph machine.

Authorities in law, medicine and psychology will be guest lecturers, as will experienced polygraph examiners. The curriculum includes interrogation, chart interpretation and psychology, plus legal, mechanical and medical aspects of polygraph examination.

The Engineering Extension Service-sponsored school is taught in cooperation with the Texas Education Agency.


