An authority on Russian polytechnic education says that U.S. public schools must offer a liberal education which includes technical understanding.

"Industrial arts courses offer a means of discovering and developing technical talents that our kids have for engineering," noted Dr. Marshall L. Schmitt, industrial arts specialist in the U.S. Office of Education.

The Texas Industrial Arts Association conference consultant said such courses provide a method of expression of technical talents. "Something about the program helps kids learn," he noted. "It has a broadening content."

THE PRINCIPAL speaker at the recent 20th Industrial Arts Teachers Conference at the MSC stressed to more than 500 participants that "school administrators are accepting industrial arts programs more and more as a good vehicle for learning, for the slower student and engineeringoriented kids."

In stressing a positive approach to industrial arts programs, Schmitt noted they offer a purposeful activity and a practical approach to real learning sit-

He studied Russian polytechnic education as an appointed member of a three-man team which toured the U.S.S.R. in 1959.

"People didn't realize the Soviets had such a well-developed polytechnic program," he said.


THE U. S. has a much broader program, indicated the 10-year official of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.




