

Consolidated H.S. Newspaper Wins Several Awards

A&M Consolidated High School's newspaper, the "Paper Tiger," won several awards at the Interscholastic League competition in Austin. The competition was sponsored by the University of Texas journalism department. The paper won the "Merit Award" for high journalistic standards. Mary Griffin, editor, won third place in the Class 3-A editorial writing contest and Fran Haugen, staff writer, won third in Class A news writing. A&M Consolidated was one of four schools which won more than one award in all divisions. There were seven categories in the state, with several hundred competitors in each category.

Architecture Meet Slated

Seven colleges have been invited to an April 10 open house at Texas A&M's School of Architecture. Chartier Newton, assistant professor of architecture, said students and faculty members from selected colleges with pre-engineering, pre-architecture and art programs are expected. Invitations have been sent to the University of Dallas, University of Texas at Arlington, San Antonio College, Trinity University, Blinn Junior College, University of St. Thomas, and Paris Junior College. Visitors will meet with second and third year classes in architecture history, building structures, visual arts, landscape architecture and design. Informal discussions of A&M programs are planned following luncheon in the School of Architecture court yard. Faculty members will discuss future curriculum changes. Newton said visitors will have an opportunity to see how A&M designs work during reviews of design problems in progress by third year design students. Displays of work by visual arts and design classes will be exhibited.

Geology Profs To Attend Geological Meet This Week

Two Texas A&M geology professors will attend the first annual South Central Section meeting of the Geological Society of America in Norman, Okla., this week. The section's charter secretary-measurer re-elected for a second term, Dr. Melvin C. Schroeder will attend business sessions. Dr. James E. Case, associate professor of geology and geography, will co-chair a technical session on structural geology with William R. Muehlberger of Texas. Muehlberger is chairman of UT's geology department. Schroeder said more than 300 participants from Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas are expected for the five-day meeting beginning Wednesday. As secretary, he did other work on the section bylaws and petitioned GSA for establishment of the section.
