Ag Track Team In Texas Relays

By JERRY GRISHAM Texas A&M's Randy Matson joins three other world record holders in Austin Friday and Saturday for the 40th edition of the Texas Relays.

IN ADDITION to the Aggie shot-putter, Jim Ryun, Ralph Boston and the relay team of Southern University of Baton Rouge will be entered in the meet.

Matson, the world's best at tossing the 16-pound shot, has been sidelined from his specialty the past two weeks because of an injured hand. The hand gave him trouble in practice this week but he will throw in competition anyway.

Meanwhile, Matson hasn't been idle. He sailed the discus 200 feet, 7 1/2 inches two weeks ago, surpassing his own NCAA mark of 199-7 1/2.

IN FRIDAY'S competition Matson will throw in the shot put preliminaries at 10 a.m. He also will compete in the discus prelims and finals that afternoon. Finals in the shot put will be Saturday at 3:30 p.m.

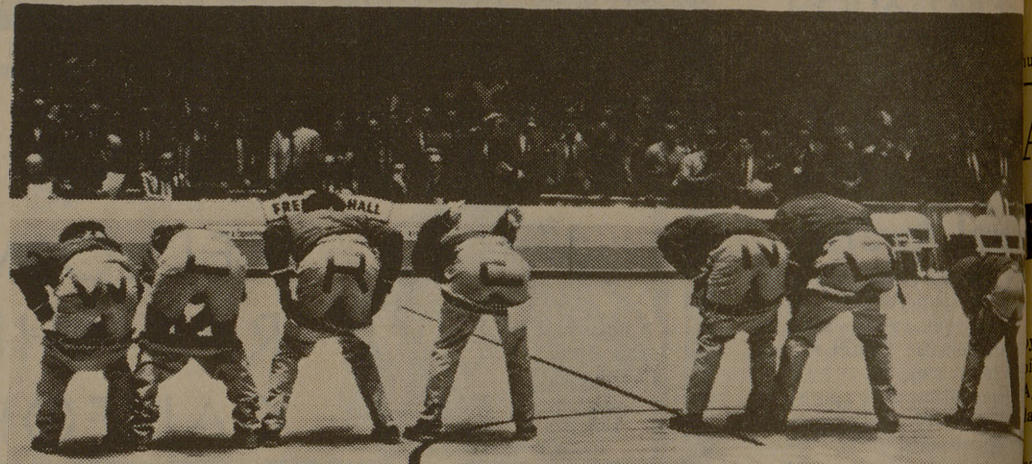
George Resley will join Matson in throwing the shot for A&M.

Coach Charles Thomas has announced the other members of the track team entered in the meet: 440 relay — Gary Abernathy, Steve O'Neal, Aric Britt and Jack White; 880 relay — Britt, O'Neal, Larry McGough and White; mile relay — White, Mike Boyd, McGough and Richard Ball.

Two mile relay — Mike Synyard, Willie Rodriguez, Robert Vaughan and Chris Conley; distance medley relay — Boyd, Vaughan, Rodriguez and Conley; 100 dash — Abernathy; 440 hurdles — Deward Strong and Richard Ball; 120 hurdles — Strong and O'Neal; pole vault — Henry Rollins; high jump — Steve Holtz; board jump — O'Neal; javelin — Donny Ayers.

RYUN, THE holder of the world record for the mile, will not compete in his specialty but will run the anchor on the Kansas relay teams. Ralph Boston, the broad jump champ, will be entered in the open broad jump and Southern University, co-holders of the world 440 and mile relay standards, will enter usual strong baton teams.

In the All-America Intercollegiate Golf Tournament in Houston, the pairings have been made.

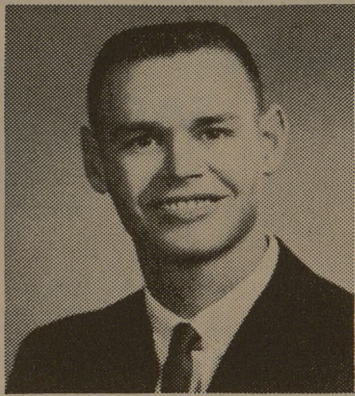
Clay Faces First Defeat As Army Induction Nears

HOUSTON (AP) — Heavyweight champion Cassius Clay suffered a one-two punch setback Wednesday in his fight to avoid being drafted into the U. S. Army. First, the Houston draft board ordered him to report for induction April 28. Shortly thereafter, a U. S. District Court at Louisville, Ky. refused to delay his induction on grounds of racial discrimination. Clay could not be reached for comment but his Houston attorney indicated the champion would continue his efforts to

avoid induction on the grounds he is a Muslim minister. A Houston draft board spokesman said Clay's induction notice was sent out in the morning mail Wednesday shortly after his draft board status change request from Louisville was received by the local board. The Louisville board had set April 11 as the induction date but Clay received the delay by having his case referred to Houston which he now claims as his home. "There was an April 28 call

already set up before we received approval of his request to be in our jurisdiction," Houston Draft Board spokesman said. "There are several other cases included in the call. He has no special privileges that apply to him." At Louisville Judge James Gordon declined to create a three-man panel to hear all contentions that discrimination was involved because no cases were on the board that all were called up.
