Dr. Wayne C. Hall, A&M's academic vice president and graduate dean, said Dr. Berner replaces Dr. James G. Potter, who will become Physics Department head at the Florida Institute of Technology at Melbourne.

Dr. Hall said Berner will continue teaching and research in oceanography in addition to parttime duties as assistant dean.


