

# \$17,640 Given **For Publication**

A \$17,640 National Science Foundation grant to Texas A&M for publishing results of Southeastern Pacific oceanographic research has been announced by resident Earl Rudder.

The 18-month grant will be inder direction of Dr. Edward Chinn, associate professor of biology at the A&M Marine Laboratory at Galveston.

Administration of the grant will be by A&M's Research Foun-

The project, "Editing of Scientific Results of the R/V Anton Brun Program in the Southeastern Pacific Ocean," will incorpating scientists from all over the world into bound volumes, Dr. Chinn said.

"Nine major cruises, all scientific data and routine chemistry work will be included," he added. Publication will cover a year of cruises by the Anton Brun. The ship is an ex-presidential yacht Williamsburg converted for the iological oceanographic program lirected by Chinn for NSF.

"All scientists will work up reults and submit them to use for nclusion in the publication," he continued. "When we have accumulated enough, the expediionary reports will be bound into olumes." Chinn will edit the re-

# **LowryIsCited** By Institute

Professor Stanley H. Lowry of Texas A&M has received an American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics outstanding facilty advisor citation.

The aerospace engineering professor was presented the citation Monday by Dr. Richard E. Wainerdi, associate dean of engineer-

Lowry, 45, advises the 77-member A&M branch of AIAA. The institute lists over 35,000 members nationally.

Announcement of the award from the New York AIAA office was made by David Z. Hazen, chairman of the educational and student affairs committee. The award, based on evaluation of student activities, originated in the national office.

Lowry is an associate professor in the Aerospace Engineering Department, headed by A. E. Cronk. He came to A&M in 1964 from Oklahoma. The New York-born ngineer studied at Purdue, Yale, and Minnesota, where his masters egree was awarded in 1947.




