Bonfire Is Spirit Of A&M

The "world's largest bonfire" symbolizing the burning desire of the Texas Aggies to beat the Texas University Longhorns in football Thanksgiving Day, is ignited each year during the week preceding the game.

Last year's 85-foot structure, built of 30-foot logs stacked end on end, was doused with hundreds of gallons of fuel to insure that it would be roaring hot.

While yell leaders toss torches to touch off the fire, A&M students stand at attention and sing the school song, "The Spirit of Aggieland."

Traditionally, Aggies follow with yells far into the night.

One of the oldest traditions of Aggies, the bonfire has been an annual affair since 1909. In addition to the burning desire to beat t.u., the classic blaze reflects the undying flame of love that every loyal Aggie carries in his heart for the school.

That 1909 stack of 12 feet was merely a campfire compared to today's woodpile. In 1960, the Aggies went all out to set a record of 101 feet.

Security is tight for the bonfire area on the south side of the campus.
