### A&M Professor To Undertake Studies In Alaska Concerning Meteorological Satellite Observations

Dr. Aylmer H. Thompson, Texas A&M professor, will study meteorological satellite observations in Alaska during the 1967-68 school year.

He will be visiting professor of geophysics at the University of Alaska Sept. 1 through Aug. 31, 1968, on a year's leave of absence, announced Dr. Vance E. Moyer, A&M Meteorology Department head.

Thompson will work at the NASA satellite readout station at Gilmore Creek, near the Alaska campus and Fairbanks. Data from polar-orbiting TOS satellites are collected at the station.

Thompson worked in the Line Islands Experiment in the Pacific, in which National Center for Atmospheric Research scientists sought data on surface and atmospheric conditions for correlation with advanced Technology Satellite (ATS-1) pictures. ATS-1 is in an equatorial stationary orbit.

Thompson spent most of February and March on Hawaii, Christmas, Palmyra and Fanning Islands for observations, measurements and photo work.

The professor worked with Tiros and Nimbus satellite observations.

The satellite meteorologist received degrees at UCLA with the Ph.D. awarded in 1960 when he joined the A&M meteorology faculty.
