

Mail Orders Available For Town Hall Series

Mail orders for Bryan Rotary Community Series and Texas Memorial Student Center's Town Hall Series begin Aug. 28. Series officials announced orders should be mailed to Town Hall, Box 5718, College Station, Texas 77840. Orders by mail should be postmarked not later than Sept. 4. Personal delivery of orders will be accepted at the MSC Student Program Office.

Orders are to be filled in the sequence received. Community Series season tickets sell for \$13.50 each. Price of Town Hall season tickets varies depending on reserved seat locations. Faculty-staff prices are \$8 or \$9. Students may reserve season tickets for \$2 or \$3, while tickets for spouses are \$6 or \$7. Patrons pay \$10 and \$11.

A major campaign by the Bryan Rotary Club to sell 1,250 season tickets to the Community Series opens Sept. 7. Individual members will sell tickets and Rotarians and their wives will operate a counter at the Bryan Civic Auditorium through Sept. 12. Except for Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 9-10, booths will be manned from 12:30 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Tickets also will be available at the MSC Student Program Office from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. weekdays. Texas A&M enrollees with student activity cards will have a two-day priority period to purchase \$1.50 tickets for four Community Series presentations. They will be admitted free to a fifth program. For the four Bryan Civic Auditorium programs in the Community Series, 226 seats will be available to A&M students. After the student priority periods, any remaining tickets will be available to the public at \$3.50 each at the MSC Student Program Office.

The Community Series slate includes the Houston Symphony on Sept. 29, flamenco guitarist Carlos Montoya Oct. 30, "Roar of the Greasepaint, Smell of the Crowd" Feb. 13, Metropolitan Opera Soprano Mary Costa March 8, and pianist Lorin Hollander April 9. Miss Costa's performance is set in G. Rolfe White Coliseum, the others in Bryan's Civic Auditorium.
