

Ponies Search High And Low For Sound QB

DALLAS. (AP)—Just hint you once played a down at quarterback and you'll be on the Southern Methodist University football team with ankle wraps and knees braced in a matter of seconds.

Quarterbacks with sound legs are what Coach Hayden Fry needs most as he thinks back week, recalls all the fuss and flurry his team and sub-quarterback, Ines Perez, caused with the gripping 20-17 victory over Texas A&M on national television.

Then he compares it with the week when the aftermath of a 21-0 defeat by Missouri is a thing to try one's soul.

Mike Livingston, the starting quarterback, went out with a torn ligament in his right knee and didn't play at all the half in the Aggie game. Ines Perez, the 5-4 marvel, stepped in and passed Southern Methodist victory with only four seconds left.

Then last week Perez started the game against Missouri, completed six of nine passes for 140 yards when a couple of linemen weighing a combined 400 pounds or so hit him as he was trying to pivot. He got a jammed right knee and strained tendon in the foot.

Perez had to keep his foot on a water bucket while on the bench and by the end of the game that wasn't doing much good.

So Fry is looking for quarterbacks while comparing the situation with 1964 when he had the injured signal callers and only one game.

"We hope Livingston can come back by the time of the Minnesota game. SMU has this week but meets Minnesota Oct. 7, but have no assurance that he will be," said Fry sadly. "He and Perez have the type of injuries that could persist all season."

Fry has turned to Eddie Vande, a junior college transfer; Floyd, a sophomore who plays some at quarterback in high school but is noted more for defense, and Chuck Hixson, a sophomore who can pass. All are virtually untried but they'll be to carry on with Fry hoping his luck holds up better than it did in 1964.

All is dark on the Hilltop and Fry is thinking about how much difference one week can make in this exciting but erratic game of football.

Southwest Texas has top offense

NACOGDOCHES. (AP)—Southwest Texas and Howard Payne players lead all the individual football statistics in the Lone Star Conference after two weeks of the season.

Jesse Perkins of Southwest Texas leads in total offense with 312 yards and in passing with 88 yards after two games. Howard Payne's James Harris is the top rusher with 198 yards in two games. He also is the scoring leader with 30 points.

Cliff Mitchell of Southwest Texas has caught the most passes, nine for 97 yards, and James Williamson of Howard Payne is first in punting, averaging 44 yards on 13 kicks.

In team statistics, East Texas leads in total offense with 883 yards a game and in rushing offense with 242 yards. Sul Ross is the passing leader, completing 52 per cent of its tosses for an average of 155 yards a game.

On defense McMurry has had two opponents to an average of 43 yards total offense per game while Southwest Texas has yielded only 16 yards in rushing to two teams.

SIX EX-SPARTANS COACH EAST LANSING, Mich. (AP)—The addition of two former Michigan State players on Duffy Daugherty's coaching staff brings to six the number of former Spartans who are coaching on the campus.

Dave Smith, an end in the early 50s, is now assistant backfield coach. George Perles, a State lineman 10 years ago, was added to the staff during the summer.

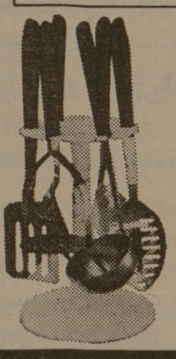

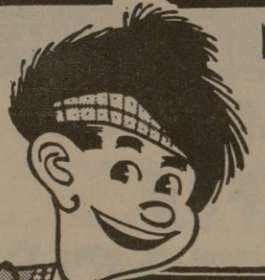
