

Long currently is best known as a wingback-split end on A&M's football unit. But, name your game and Long is apt to pin back your ears in nothing flat.

Last spring he decided to see if he could help coach Tom Chandler's Aggies in baseball. He quickly won the centerfield post and was named on the SWC second-team at the season's end.

He southpaws his way around the golf course in the 70s, plays a smashing game of tennis, can virtually run the table in pool, is an adept basketball player and could probable be a seven-sport star at Aggieland if there wasn't a rule about having to attend

Many consider him A&M's best pass receiver though he isn't the fastest man on the club. He tends to "out-quick" the secondary rather than just out-run the foes. 
