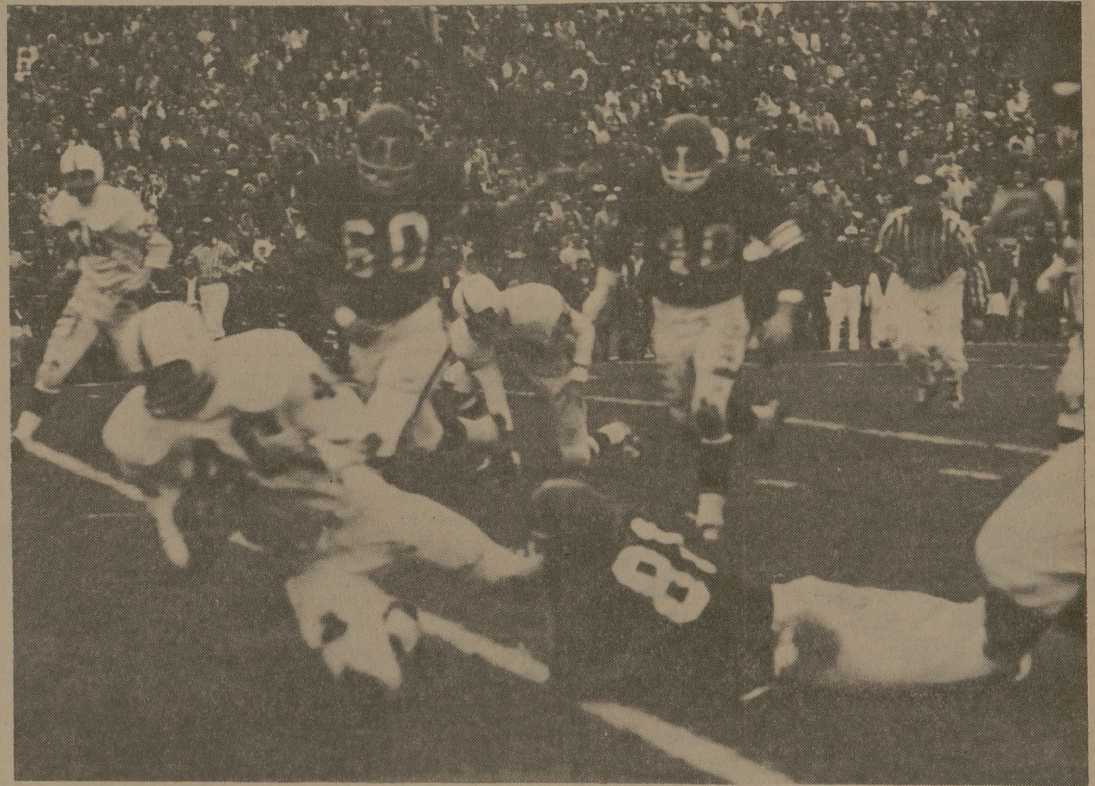
Aggies Are On Top After 'Cotton-Pickin' Victory

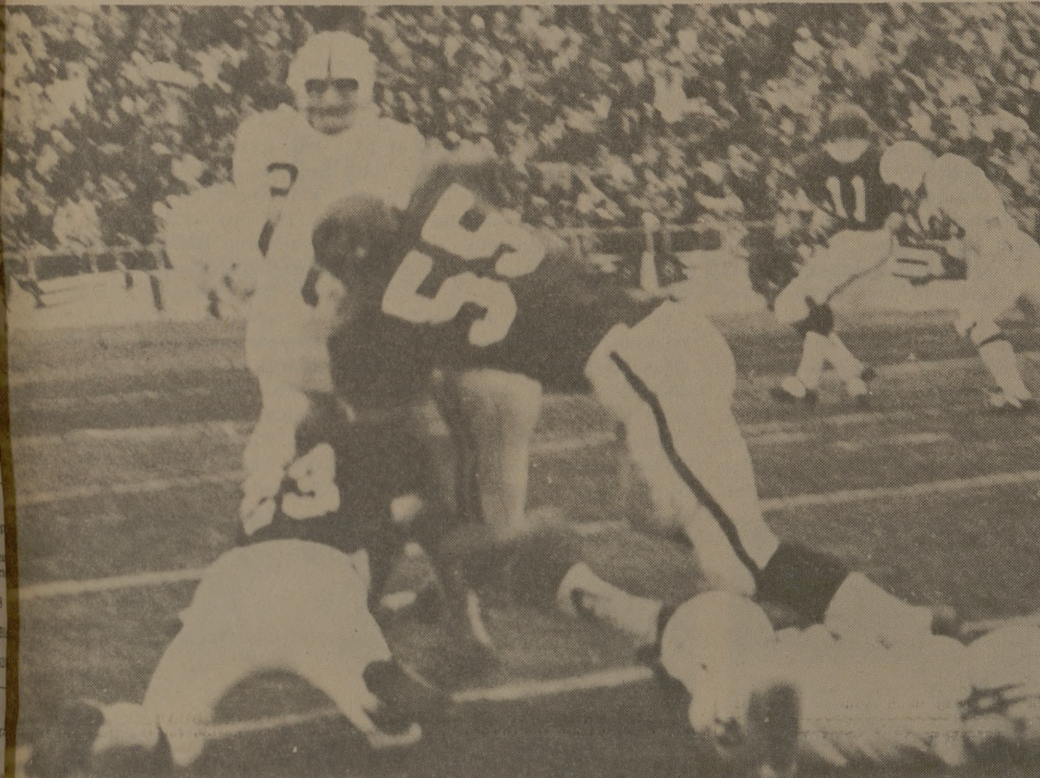
