Summer Travel

Summer travel candidates are being sought by Programa de Educacion Interamericana at Texas A&M.

Five graduate students will be employed as educational attaches for intercultural survey tour work next summer.

Research teams will tour Barbados, Jamaica, Ecuador, Costa Rica, Panama, Venezuela and Paraguay in 1968, announced Dr.

Earl Jones, director.

Programa, part of A&M's College of Liberal Arts, is designed to improve knowledge and understanding of Latin American cultures in Texas' educational system.

Attache duties include assistance on materials research work and preparation during the school year. During travel in one of five areas during the summer, the graduate student provides team teacher-members background information on the country and its

education system and handles travel arrangements.

"One requirement is that the student be free to travel between June 22 and July 20," Jones added.

Graduate Grant

Texas A&M University has been awarded a \$64,710 National Sci-

ence Foundation grant for its graduate program in econometrics, announced Graduate Dean Wayne C. Hall.

Dean Hall said Texas A&M offers the only econometrics graduate program in the Southwest.

Econometric courses, which include economics, mathematics and statistics, are administered by the Department of Economics and jointly sponsored by the university's Institute of Statistics.

The funds are specifically designated for support of "A New

Program of Study in Econometrics." Dr. M. L. Greenhut, head of the Economics Department, was named principal investigator.

Dean Hall said the funds will be used for faculty development, graduate traineeships and computer expenses.

Club at Texas A&M University.

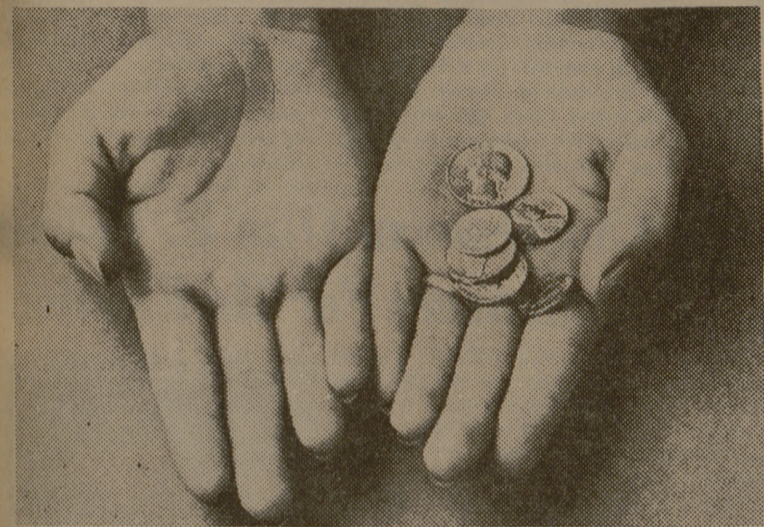
The senior finance major from Fayetteville will head the student organization during 1968.

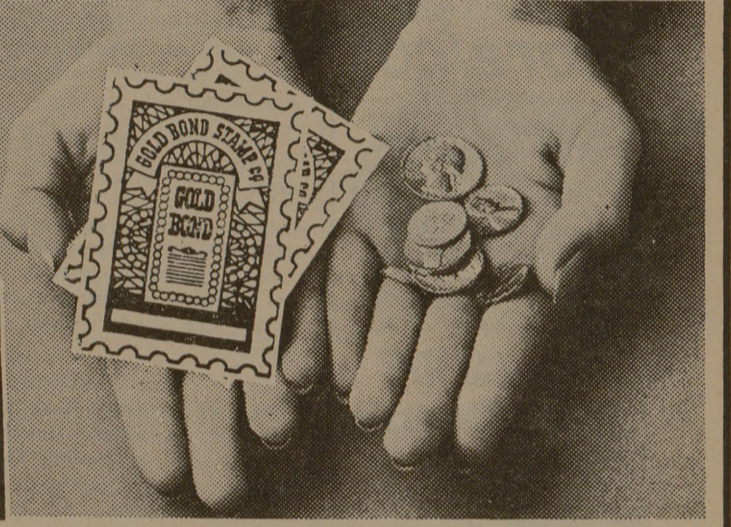
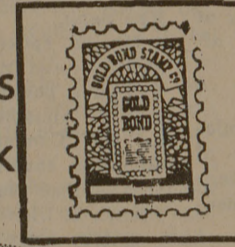
Faculty advisor is Dr. John M. Skrivanek, modern languages professor who instructs Czech courses.

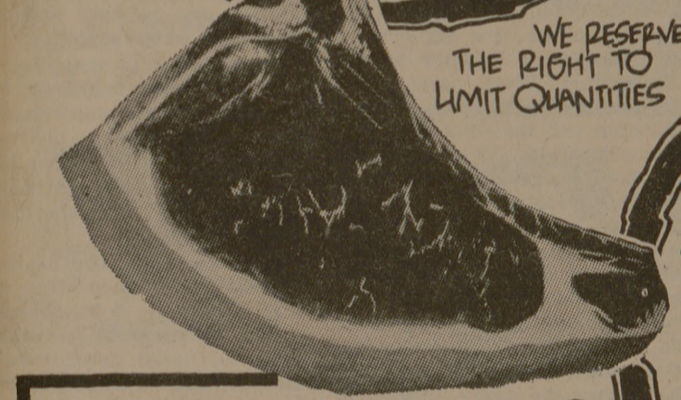
