## ForEd.Program Texas A&M's Educational Tele-

vision Department hitched up its mobile video-tape unit Thursday for on-site shooting at Bryan's Crockett Elementary School.

ETV Associate Producer Norman Godwin said playground scenes at the Bryan school will be used to introduce a 30-minute program illustrating exemplary practices in early childhood education.

The program, entitled "A Happy Start," is aimed at parents of pre-school children and will be aired in several Texas cities after an initial showing in Lufkin Feb. 13.

Godwin said the program is part of "Project RA-TOD" (Research Application — Techniques of Dissemination), a \$50,000 federally-funded study being conducted by the Lufkin Independent School District and Texas A&M, in cooperation with the Texas Education Agency.

Dr. Roger Harrell, assistant professor of education at A&M, is project director.

Segments of the program showing parents and pre-school children were taped earlier in the ETV campus studios.

### **Baptists Exclude Hippies**, Offbeats **From Texas School**

BROWNWOOD (AP) - Howard Payne College announced Thursday a policy barring "hippies and other bizarre personalities" from enrollment at the Baptist-supported institution.

The Howard Payne board said those who were not hippies when they enrolled but became so later "will be asked either to change their ways or to withdraw."
