

Some cooperating in a precise study of the shifting and upheaval of the earth due to earthquakes in nental mass. northwestern Colombia. tists has four phases: Dr. James E. Case, associate professor of geology and geophysics at Texas A&M and Richard W. Moore of Dallas, an A&M graduate student, are in Panama

City initiating the research.

Case, who did a similar study in Alaska after the Good Friday earthquake, is the principal United States investigator and Professors Luis Guillermo Duran and Alfonso Lopez are the Colombian investigators.

SPECIAL EFFORTS will be made to establish a number of precise, gravity recoverable "bench marks" that can be reoccupied after major earthquakes to aid in determining the extent of vertical changes in land level.

The gravity meters used are so sensitive they can detect upheavals of about a foot and a half.
