Full Weekend Of Sports At A&M

Today kicks off a big weekend of sports events on the A&M campus.

Coach Tom Chandler's 2-1 Aggie baseball team is hosting St. Mary's of San Antonio at Bryan's Travis Park today.

The Texas Aggie track squad will also be in action this weekend. Coach Charlie Thomas' cindermen will host Rice and Texas in a triangular meet at Kyle Field.

Coach Art Adamson's swimmers will be in action as they host Southern Methodist in a dual meet Saturday at Downs Natatorium.

Friday night, the Aggie basketballers will finish their 1967-68 season hosting SMU's quintet. Coach Shelby Metcalf's cagers were eliminated from the conference race Tuesday night in a heartbreaking 83-81 setback to Texas Tech.

SMU who were defending champions, are 5-8 for conference play and 6-17 overall.

The Mustangs lost four starters through graduation and have had a rebuilding year. But, as most SWC fans know, there isn't much difference between two conference teams, regardless of record.

Finally, G. Rollie White Coliseum will be the site Saturday of the region three boys basketball tournament in Classes AA

and A. The pairings were announced Wednesday.

In class A, Cayuga of district 23 plays Rains (Emory) of district 18 at 8:45 a.m. in the day's opener. Central (Pollock) of district 21 meets West Sabina (Pine-land) of district 20 at 10:15 a.m.

The two winners play for the regional championship and a berth in the state tournament at 7:15 p.m. In class AA, Hardin-Jefferson (Sour Lake) of district 23 plays Copperas Cove at 11:45 a.m. and Klein (Spring) plays Kirbyville at 1:15 p.m.

Texas Nine Takes Fourth Straight Win

AUSTIN (AP) — Texas won its fourth straight baseball game, beating Sam Houston 9-1 Wednesday behind a 15-hit attack and five-hit pitching.

Randy Peschel, who also got a triple and two singles, hit a two-run homer in the fifth for Texas. Dennis Kasper added a solo home run in the seventh when the Longhorns scored three times.

Starter James Street gave up three of Sam Houston's five hits and yielded the only run in four innings. He was the winner. Relievers Larry Horton and freshman Don Horne each gave up a hit.

The Aggies will host Texas Saturday afternoon at 2 p.m. at Bryan's Travis Park.
