Texas A&M's new Dean of the College of Agriculture, Dr. H. O. Kunkel, named two of three associate deans here today in a re-organization program which he said will emphasize the "team" concept in all future activities of the college.

John E. Hutchison, now director of the Texas Agriculture Extension Service, will be associate dean and director of that agency.

Dr. R. C. Potts, currently assistant dean of agriculture, will be associate dean for resident instruction.

The third man, who will be associate dean and director of the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station, has not yet been selected.

Kunkel first announced the new appointments during a dinner here Friday night held in his honor by A&M President Earl Rudder and the A&M System Board of Directors. Also in attendance were nine members of the farm press and seven members of the University's

Agricultural Advisory Committee.

In commenting on the new appointments, Rudder said that the dean will be responsible for all of the functions of the college. Lines of administrative action will flow through the associate deans to department heads, Experiment Station field units, and the Extension Service staff.

Kunkel said that each of the line associate deans will direct matters relating to the respective part of the college for which he is responsible. Each line associate dean, also an integral member of the executive team of the College of Agriculture.

Kunkel said the reorganization also calls for staff associate or assistant deans who will work with all facets of the College of Agriculture.

"We envision an associate dean of administrative affairs who will serve, along with the dean, to provide contact with the board scope of clientele of the college."

## Engineer Confab Expects 500

A conference on engineering education will attract 500 engineering deans, department heads and teachers to Texas A&M Thursday through Saturday.

More than 50 papers will be heard in 14 general and special sessions of the Gulf-Southwest Section meeting of the American Society for Engineering Education.

Donald A. MacArthur, deputy director for research and engineering in the Department of Defense, will be featured speaker at a Friday banquet in the Memorial Student Center.

MacArthur's office has responsibility for the Department of Defense's Project Themis programs to establish centers of excellence in universities over the nation. Texas A&M participates in two Project Themis programs.

At a "Relations With Industry" dinner meeting in the Ramada Inn, Robert E. Schuhmann of the Biomedical Engineering Department, Baylor University College of Medicine, will speak on "The Engineer in the Life Sciences." Areas to be covered in the conference include trends in engineering education, funded research, techniques of engineering teaching, innovations in subjects, new methods, modern concepts, the new student, the graduate student and facets in continuing education.

General chairman is Dr. J. George H. Thompson of A&M's Aerospace Engineering Department. Dr. Richard Thomas of Aerospace Engineering is program chairman and Dr. Jim Earle of A&M's Engineering Graphics Department, publicity chairman.
