April Weather Turns Winter Into Summer For Twin-Cities

Texas A&M Meteorology Department records surveyed by Prof. John F. Griffiths show the first hint of summer amidst traces of winter.

The department climatologist said an average warming trend of about 10 degrees usually occurs during the 30-day period, when the wind is mostly from the south or southeast, cloud coverage is complete about a third the time and clear skies account for another third.
