Secretaries Hear
Election Comments**

"The Presidential Election—1968" was the title of the address given by Dr. William C. Gibbons to the Bryan-College Station chapter of the National Secretaries Association at its monthly meeting at the Ramada Inn Tuesday.

Gibbons, head of the new department of political science, made some predictions concerning the coming national Democratic and Republican political conventions.

"There will likely be a good fight at the conventions, when the advocates of one man-one vote clash with the defenders of the present system of unit rule," he prophesied.

"This election year will see the American Party candidate, Gov. George Wallace, exerting an unusually great influence over both the Democratic and Republican camps, and there is a possibility of a fourth party emerging before November, to further split the major political parties' votes," Gibbons continued.

A question and answer period followed Gibbons' address.
