Dr. J. E. Marsh Sr., asso with the Texas A&M hospital for 34 years, died Sunday at the

Services for the retired physician were held Tuesday in the Hillier Funeral Home chapel, with the Rev. H. Bruce Fisher of the A&M Presbyterian Church officiating. Burial was in Bryan City Cemetery.

Dr. Marsh came to A&M in 1924 to practice as medical doc-tor. He served at the college hos-pital until 1941, when he went on full hospital staff assignment with the university. He retired in

The World War I veteran who served in the Navy was a graduate of Baylor and the University of Texas Medical School. Before coming to A&M, he was on the staff of Scott-White Hospital in Temple.

Anderson Urges **Public Support**

Of the total dog population in the city, it is ironic that only 175 dog tags have been sold this year, Mayor Anderson reports. A total of 156 dogs have been picked up through June. The mayor concluded that enforcement of the ordinance will continue and urged the co-operation of all citizens. If there are any questions on the ordinance he asked that the citizens get in touch with the police department.
