

Retired A&M Physician Dies

Dr. J. E. Marsh Sr., associated with the Texas A&M hospital for 34 years, died Sunday at the age of 75.

Services for the retired physician were held Tuesday in the Hillier Funeral Home chapel, with the Rev. H. Bruce Fisher of the A&M Presbyterian Church officiating. Burial was in Bryan City Cemetery.

Dr. Marsh came to A&M in 1924 to practice as medical doctor. He served at the college hospital until 1941, when he went on full hospital staff assignment with the university. He retired in 1958.

The World War I veteran, who served in the Navy as a graduate of Baylor and the University of Texas Medical School. Before coming to A&M, he was on the staff of Scott-White Hospital in Temple.

Dr. Marsh was member of several Masonic bodies and Texas and American Medical Associations. He was an elder of the A&M Presbyterian Church.

Survivors include the wife, Grace Harlan Marsh; a daughter, Mrs. Neal Reeves of Dallas; son, Dr. J. E. Marsh Jr. of Bryan; sister, Mrs. A. L. Delaney of Liberty; three brothers, C. B. Marsh of Livingston, C. C. Marsh of Liberty and G. J. Marsh of Forth Worth, and three grandchildren.

Pallbearers were Dr. M. T. Harrington, George A. Adams Jr., Carl T. Sprague, M. L. Cashion, Dr. J. P. Abbott, Lloyd D. Smith, R. G. Reeves and D. W. Williams.

Honorary pallbearers included all physicians of the Brazos-Robertson Counties Medical Association.

Anderson Urges Public Support

The co-operation of the public in support of the ordinance against dogs running at large in the city was urged today by College Station Mayor D. A. "Andy" Anderson.

An increasing number of complaints are being received by the city on this violation, the mayor reported.

Since the beginning of the year over ten people have been bitten by such animals.

New citizens in our community are perhaps unaware that there is an ordinance which prohibits dogs running at large, the mayor said.

With the hot summer months rabies is a problem. Also, more and more people in the community are walking, he continued. Others report damage to personal property by dogs running at large.

Of the total dog population in the city, it is ironic that only 175 dog tags have been sold this year, Mayor Anderson reports. A total of 156 dogs have been picked up through June. The mayor concluded that enforcement of the ordinance will continue and urged the co-operation of all citizens. If there are any questions on the ordinance he asked that the citizens get in touch with the police department.
