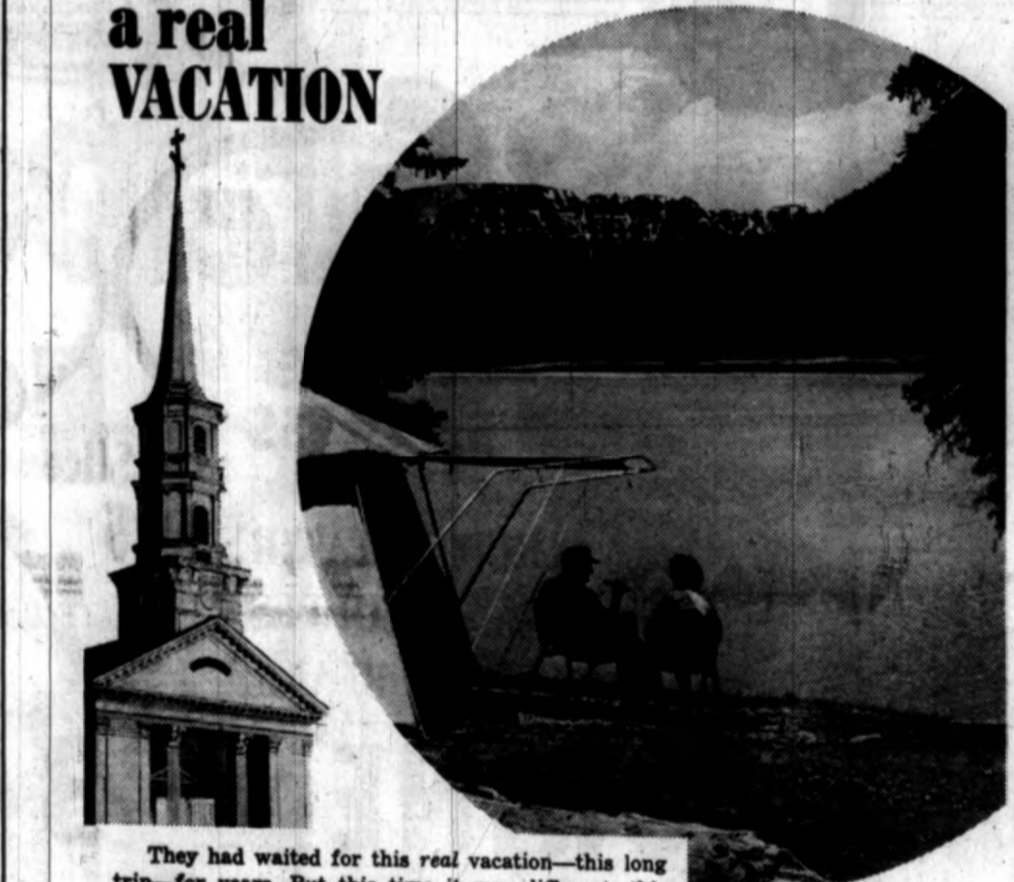
The Agricultural Adult Education Specialist Program, percolating quietly but efficiently, has provided specialized training for 53,466 Texans in its 10 years of operation. Figures just released by the Texas A&M Agricultural Education Department show that the system which began in 1958 with one instructor or training specialist has grown to the current 11. That same year, 177 courses were held throughout the state, and a total of 1,981 persons participated. This year, July 1, 1967-June 30, 1968, 278 courses were conducted for 5,901 participants. THE PEAK YEAR was in 1965, when 6,693 people attended 327 courses around the state. What is the Agricultural Adult Education Specialist Program, and what are its purposes? Bob Jaaka of the A&M Agricultural Education Department, program coordinator and one of the first specialists back in 1958, said the program is a cooperative venture between A&M University and the Texas Education Agency in Austin. It is strictly for rural adults.

Courses are organized by local high school vocational agricultural teachers and taught by agricultural education specialists from A&M. COURSES COVER farm arc welding, oxyacetylene welding, tractor maintenance, pasture improvement, beef and swine production, farm management, farm electrification and electric motors. Training, Jaska said, is conducted by the specialists on a short course basis and under auspices of the public schools. JASKA LISTED these objectives of the program: —To enable vocational agriculture teachers to provide improved educational services for rural people by making specialized training available to them. —To stimulate the formation of adult and young farmer organizations for year-round educational programs. —To help vocational agriculture teachers carry out their responsibilities in adult and young farmer education. There is one supervisor in each of the 10 designated areas of vocational agriculture in Texas.
